Tim Ingalls bikes in the Pan-Mass Challenge this Sunday, please donate tonight!

This Sunday, Tim rides in the Pan-Mass Challenge so please make your donation to him tonight or go to <http://pmc.timingalls.com> to donate. The Pan-Mass Challenge is the nation's pioneer charity bike-a-thon that raises more money than any other athletic fund-raising event in the country. Tim will be among the more than 5,000 cyclists who will ride with the collective goal of raising millions of dollars for lifesaving cancer research and care for adult and pediatric cancer patients at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute through its Jimmy Fund. Tim was diagnosed with cancer in February 2007. While receiving chemo and radiation treatment he still maintained perfect attendance in the league. In January of 2008 he was declared in remission and has been that way for over a year and half. Please help if you can.

Vishal sparks Spartans to 18-7 victory with 4 runouts, his 2nd time, and 4th 5-game win!

For the first time this season a player came close to a perfect night as Vishal scored 4 runouts, his 2nd time doing so in his years with the league. In second place by just 6 points last week, Spartans narrowed the gap to 5 this week after scoring 3,4,4,3,4 and never letting their opponent in the game. Posting 3 points apiece to assist Vishal's amazing offense were Jateen, Bob, Bonecrusher and Khan. Mario, who enjoys shooting first for Lucky Shot, literally didn't get a shot at Vishal so the offense was picked up by Zaldy, Jim and Sin with 2 each, and Fitzy with 1. The battle lines will be drawn tonight as Vishal, ranked 1st in the league, draws Dan, #3 shooter and record holder for most runouts, in Spartans vs Ballbusters while Lucky Shot looks to back on a winning streak against Far Cues.

Callaluca makes his mark with 2nd 5-game win; Hot Shots sweeps 5th to finish 17-8!

It's full speed ahead for the league's top ranked team who never gave Over The Hill a chance to get into their match last week. It began with a 3-2 first round lead for Hot Shots and another 4 in the 2nd put them up 7-3 after 2. Over The Hill edged them out 3-2 in the middle to tighten the lead to 9-6 but Hot Shots added 3 in the 4th and swept the 5th for the 17-8 finale. Joe led Hot Shots' shooting with his 2nd 5-game win and 3rd runout, Brian posted 4, Mike and Fran tripled, and Fran added 2. Fred picked up 3 Ws to head Over The Hill's effort, Denis and Ron doubled, and Denis Jr added one. It's a must win for Hot Shots tonight who faces Far Cues and has Spartans waiting in the wings to slide up the ranks while Over The Hill faces Cues Gone Wild.

Shaft makes short work of Rack N Roll w/4th round match W; sweep of 5th nets 19-6 final!

Shaft shot 4-1 in the 1st round, 3-2 in the 2nd, 4-1 again in the 3rd and added another 3 in the 4th to take an early match win against Rack N Roll but their final round sweep was the 19-6 icing on the cake. The Undertaker posted his 7th and 8th runouts in his 2nd 5-game win to lead Shaft's offense while Denis, Rich and Jim sunk 4 apiece, and Tim added 2. Chris pitched in the most points for Rack N Roll scoring 3 followed by Jack, Brian and Paul who split 3. It's game time for Shaft who can't slip up tonight as they fire up their offense against One Bad Ass Team who trails them in 4th place but leads in win points while Rack N Roll faces 5th ranked TCB.

Keith & Ed pour it on w/5-pointers, Steve runs 4th as TCB finishes early match W 16-9!

It was Ed's 2nd 5-pointer and Keith's 1st that made the difference in TCB's 16-9 win over Ballbusters last week. TCB just couldn't be stopped as they opened their match with a 3-2 lead, swept the 2nd to go up 8-2, added 6 of the next 10 for a 4th round match win, and picked up another 2 in the final round to shut it down 16-9. Steve assisted Ed and Keith's super offense with 3 including his 4th runout, Chuck doubled also including his 4th runout, and Claude tapped in his 2nd runout. Bob drilled in 4 points to lead for Ballbusters, Dan put in 3 points including his league-leading 10th runout, and Dennis added 2, one being his 1st runout. Tonight TCB matches up with Rack N Roll and Ballbusters faces Spartans.

Squeeze play for Cues Gone Wild who rallies in final round to pull out close 14-11 victory!

At the midway point in their match against 6th place Cues Gone Wild, Far Cues was ahead 8-7 after nearly sweeping the 3rd got them back in the game from a 6-4 deficit. Unfortunately for Far Cues, Cues Gone Wild answered with 4 in the 4th to pull ahead 11-9 and added another 3 in the final round to finish the match 14-11. Jim is back on track after scoring his 2nd 5-game win this season, Dave assisted his lead with 3, and Andy, Tim and Tuck split 6. Big Daddy, Bob and Cuz tripled to lead the offense for Far Cues while Double G added 2. Cues Gone Wild needs a win against Over The Hill tonight to keep them moving up the ranks while Far Cues breaks racks with Lucky Shot.

Tom & Eugene each run twice for their teams; One Bad Ass Team prevails in 14-11 win!

One only has to look at the score sheet to see that Tom and Eugene were pretty even matched. In their 5-game match, Eugene ran out twice as did Tom so each had to rely on his team to pick up the offense. After trading 3-2 leads on both sides for the 1st 4 rounds, One Bad Ass Team allowed The Aimless Bunch just 1 W in the final round to take the 14-11 match win. Mike and Tom ripped their opponent's offense picking up 4 points each including Jim's 4th and 5th runouts for One Bad Ass Team while Jim B tripled and Jim S doubled. Eugene had the hot hands for The Aimless Bunch scoring a team-leading 3 points including his 3rd and 4th runouts while Tim tapped in 2, and Tonto and Tom split 2 which was Tom's 5th runout. Tonight One Bad Ass Team faces Shaft and The Aimless Bunch draws Hot Shots.
