One Bad Ass Team grabs key win vs. Cues Gone Wild, overtakes 1st place in standings!

One Bad Ass Team grabbed an early 7-3 advantage over Cues Gone Wild and then fired off three 3-2 rounds to take the match win in the 4th and wrap it up at 16-9. Doug led their offense and was flawless scoring his 2nd 5-game win followed by Jim with 4, Tom and Jim with 3 apiece, and Mike with one. Cues Gone Wild's top shot, Jim, got the best of fellow top 10 shooter, Mike, picking up 4 points while subs Josh and Steve added 4 between them, and Dave picked up one. Tonight the league's newest leader, One Bad Ass Team, defends their position against Spartans as Ballbusters pops up on the schedule against Cues Gone Wild.

Mario burns opponent w/2nd 5-pointer, Lucky Shot saved by final round rally in 15-10 win!

TCB's offense looked pretty powerful as they knocked Hot Shots out of 1st place w/14-11W!

Last season's champions, TCB, went right to work on the league's 1st place team last week and took care of business early against a very tough offensive team. Knowing there was little room for error, TCB stood tough scoring 4-1 leads in the 1st and 3rd rounds and posted 2 points in each of the remaining 3 rounds to score a 14-11 knockout punch taking Hot Shots out of 1st place. Jim was on top of their offense with 4 points followed by Steve and Claude with triples including Steve's 6th runout and Chuck and Keith with doubles.
