Estabrook notches second 13th point win as Lucky Shot clips 2nd place Hot Shots!

Lucky Shot closed out a tight game against Hot Shots with Jim's second 13-point win in just 4 weeks. Surprisingly, the 2nd and 6th ranked teams were so closely matched last week that they traded not only the first 4 rounds of their match but the first 4 games of the final round as well, bringing it down to a 12-12 tie with Brian and Jim on the line. Piloting the offense for Lucky Shot was Zaldy with 4 points followed by Mario and Jim with 3 each, Tim with 2, and Neil with 1. Walt took 4 points to lead for Hot Shots, Mike scored 3, Joe and Brian doubled, and Fran contributed 1. It's #6 Lucky Shot vs. #7 Cues Gone Wild tonight and #2 Hot Shots v top seeded One Bad Ass Team.

One Bad Ass Team continues their winning ways with 17-8 victory over Ballbusters!

One Bad Ass Team initiated their attack on Ballbusters with a 4-1 first round strike, continued the onslaught with a sweep of the 2nd round, and triumphed with an early match win following a 4-1 near sweep of the 3rd. Picking up another 4 points in the last 2 rounds wrapped up at 17-8. Mike, Tom and Doug topped their offense with 4 points apiece including Tom's 6th runout while Captain Jim tripled and Jim Shambarger added 2. The league's top shot, Dan Simoneau, led for Ballbusters with 3, Dan P. assisted with 2, and Bob and Dennis split 2. This win keeps One Bad Ass Team (13-3) alone at the top of the standings, ahead of Hot Shots by just 1 match point as they face each other in tonight's match ups while Ballbusters racks up against Rack N Roll.
